


new! MATH & SCIENCE TUTORIALS AT SCIENCE CITY, 2013

One-on-one sessions in physics and chemistry are also available.



Sessions, scheduled to run from October 2, 2013, to June 20, 2014, are generally about 50 minutes in duration. Active participation in several sessions is encouraged. Some time is taken for analyzing problem areas, setting targets and goals, and monitoring achievement results. Certificates are awarded to students successfully completing three or more sessions.

Costs:

\$10/session for small-group tutorials: grades 9-10 math and Grades 11-12 math
\$20/session for one-on-one tutorials: any grade level math or science subject
\$5/session supplement for accompanying parent/guardian (with student permission!)
